Vishaka Committee, POCSO Act

The Nashik Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Nashik Late Bindu Ramrao Deshmukh Arts, Commerce Science Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Nashik Road organized a program under the Vishaka Committee, where Advocate Anuja Nehe delivered a lecture on the POCSO Act on September 13, 2024. She explained that the POCSO Act aims to protect children from sexual abuse, exploitation, and rape, and that it applies to anyone under the age of 18. Nehe emphasized that sexual abuse can take many forms, including touch, films, songs, and other media, and that it's essential for society, especially the police, security personnel, and authorities, to take action against such crimes.

Nehe also highlighted the provisions of the POCSO Act, which include imprisonment for 7 to 20 years for those found guilty, and the importance of keeping the victim's identity confidential. She noted that in cases involving minors, a child psychologist is appointed, and the matter must be resolved within 60 days. The Act also ensures that a female officer is appointed to handle such cases, and that the accused is provided with a government-appointed lawyer if needed.

Furthermore, Nehe advised girls to be mindful of their behavior and dress code to minimize the risk of abuse, and encouraged boys to respect women and treat them with dignity. The program was attended by the Vishaka Committee coordinator and aimed to raise awareness about the POCSO Act and its provisions.

The program was attended by Dr. Mrs. Minal Barve, all female and male professors, and other dignitaries. The Chief Guest, Advocate Manuja Nehe, was welcomed with a bouquet of flowers by the In-Charge Principal.

The members of the Vishaka Committee, including Dr. Deepa Holkar, Dr. Karuna Kushare, Mrs. Rajshree Thombre, Prof. Prakash Varkari, and Prof. Yogendra Patil, were present at the event.

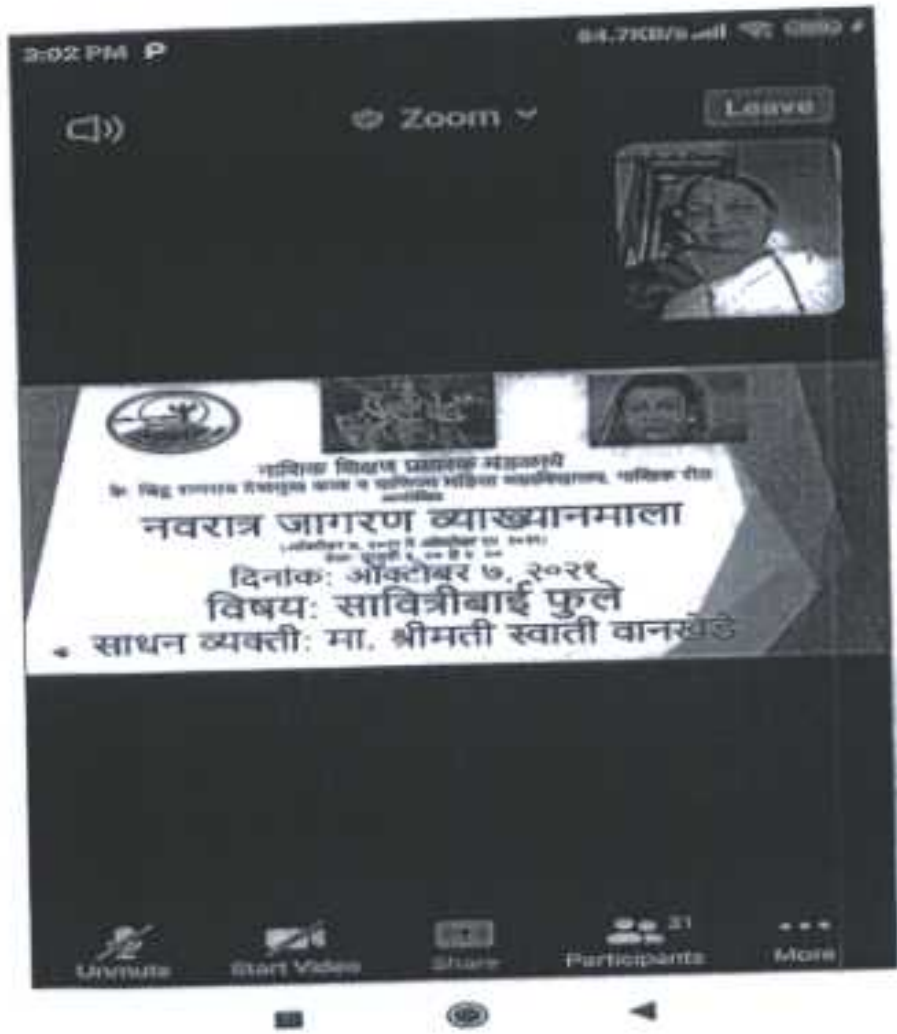

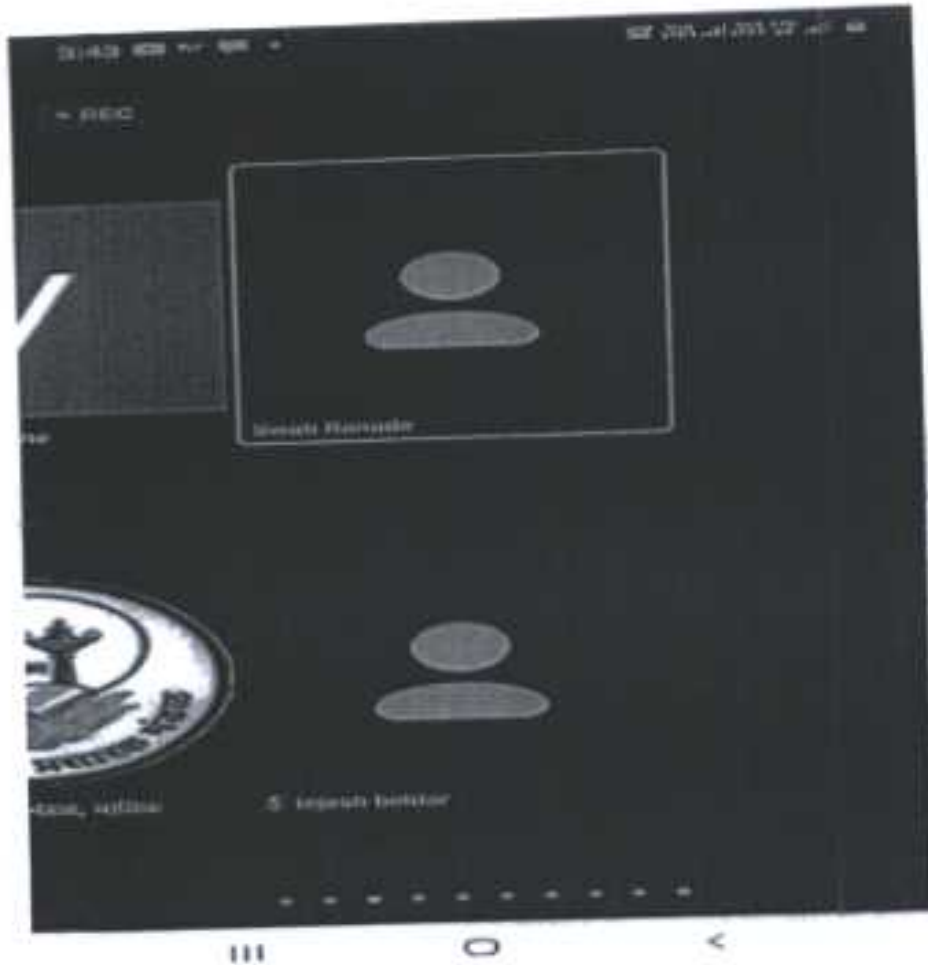

Adopted but not approved by the British, the British gave the queen a pension of five thousand rupees Approved, the Queen refused the pension and made it clear to the British that I would not receive a pension. Now the battle is inevitable and will never leave so they started preparing for war. There were 51 guns on the fort. The battle started on 25th March The queen was walking on the ramparts and the women were walking in the dress of the queen's army. Senapati Tatya

Tope came to the aid of the Queen of Jhansi with an army of twenty thousand, but the British intervened for her. The army was attacked and they had to retreat, so Lakshmi Bai left Jhansi and headed for Kalpi. She fought with an army of 200 men. During this period, Raosaheb Peshwa

The ceremony was going on and the British took advantage of the fact that there were only two hundred troops near the queen

His last sentence on 18th June 1858 was that I will never give up my Jhansi The Queen's flame did not last long in the face of British troops. The history of Queen Lakshmi Bai who was captured by the British in Jhansi. This was presented by Dr. Shubhangi Kulkarni in her lecture.




