Sathe was a Marxist-Ambedkarite mosaic, initially influenced by the communists but he later became an Ambedkarite. He is credited as a founding father of 'Dalit Literature' and played vital role in Samyukta Maharashtra Movement.





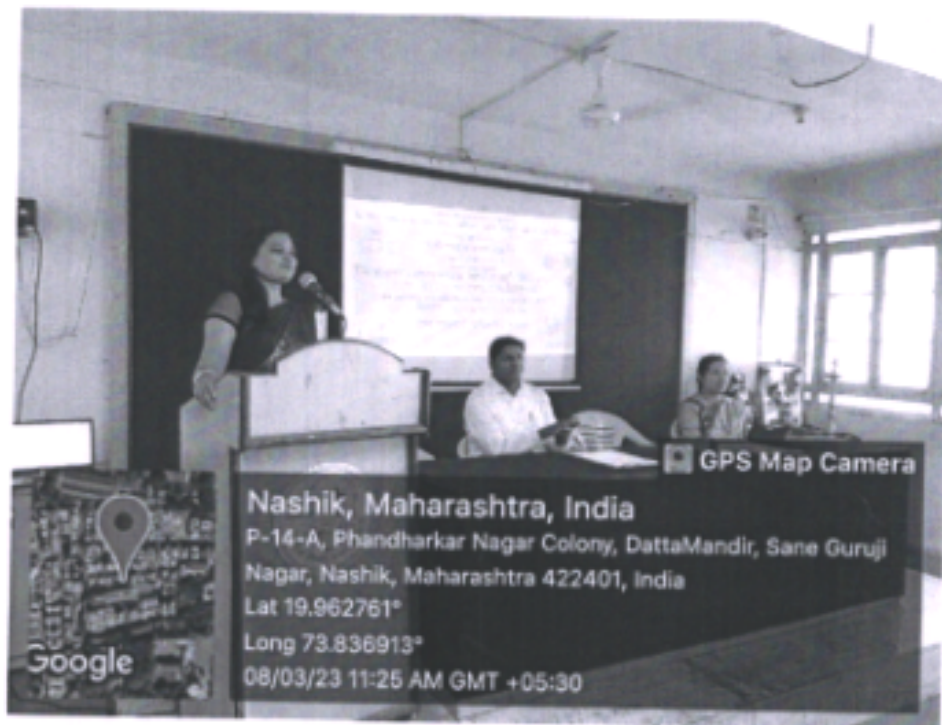

Celebration of Krantidin







Lokshahir Annabhau Sathe Birth Anniversary




**Celebration of Veer Savarkar's death anniversary in
