

Certificate Course in English Phonetics

Announcement:

The Department of English will run a certificate course, **English Phonetics**, in May 2018.

Objectives of the Course:

1. This course intent to develop understanding of sound system of English language which may help the learner in developing the pronunciation and speaking skill of English language.
2. In English there is a frequent lack of correspondence between the spelling and pronunciation of a word.
3. The goal of this course is to apply the tools and techniques of Phonetics to tackle this common practical problem.
4. A perfect duplication of the native speakers' language is not our goal in this course. For most students a reasonable goal is the ability to communicate orally with ease and efficiency:
 - it should be possible to achieve a consistent production of the basic contrasts of the sound system of the language,
 - to speak fluently and understandably in a form that requires minimum adjustment on the part of one's listeners.
 - The focus of the course will be on developing good pronunciation, diction, and intonation which will contribute to overall fluency in the English language.

The course will include following units:

1. The Speech Organs - production of speech sounds
2. Consonants - plosives, affricates, fricatives, nasals and other consonants
3. Vowels - long and short vowels, diphthongs
4. The English spelling system - problems and pointers to correct pronunciation
5. The Syllable - strong and weak syllables, syllabic consonants
6. Stress - the nature of stress, primary and secondary stress, placement of stress in a word ; stress in complex words- suffixes, prefixes, compound words.
7. Weak Forms

8. Connected Speech

9. Intonation - thought units & tone units, prosody, some functions of tones in English


