The program was moderated by Assist. Prof. Sarojini Ahire Department of Political Science. The program was attended by teachers and non-teaching staff.





## **National Voters Day 25 January**

Event Report. January 25, 2022

Nashik Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's Late. Bindu Ramrao Deshmukh Arts and Commerce Women's College jointly by Student Development Board, National Service Scheme and Department of Political Science on Tuesday 25th January 2022 from 2 to 3 pm. Retired Prof. Avinash Kolhe, Ruparel College, Mumbai, Department of Political Science gave an online lecture on 'Importance of Voting' on the occasion of National Voters' Day. In this lecture, he first explained the purpose behind celebrating January 25 as National Voters' Day. He then elaborated on the importance of voting in a democracy. India is an indirect democracy and elections need to be held in a democracy as it determines who is popular and who is not. The Election Commission has been set up in India through constitutional provisions. Voting was by two means secret and open voting. In the past ballot papers were used, now electronic voting machines are used. There is no pressure on voters as voting is secret. One of the side effects of this is that the number of electronic voting machines can be used to determine the number of votes cast at which center and the party which got the votes. 

Poor people cannot vote because they have migrated elsewhere but rich people do not vote either, so it is necessary to vote anywhere in the country and abroad. Some observers are of the opinion that voting should be done voluntarily and that voting should be made compulsory. Dr. Presented by Avinash Kolhe. 
# Teacher's Day Report 2021-22

In the field, in the garden. I used to study by throwing blankets. At that time there was no exposure like today! English was taken at a special level, but it didn't work! So that's it. Ramakant Sir allowed using the library. In gradually the fear of English vanished, and sweetness was created in difficult subjects like Phonology. Do I have to deal with rural students? This is a shortcoming. Since Akole is a rural area, the level of students was rural. Satisfaction comes when the teacher works with commitment. If the shortcomings of students in rural areas are eliminated, the performance will definitely improve. Patil says, "If we bring our Porga in a smart mind, he will become a collector ... but it does not come to his mind. Such a thing belongs to everyone."Woods are lovely dark and deep I have miles to go before I sleep...!" Don't be distracted by paying attention to the good things, don't be hesitant! "I am not accidental teacher I am committed to as a teacher...!" Even after retirement, my role is still that of a teacher! Like the lines in Keshavsuta's poem, "Wherever I go, my siblings are! Likewise, wherever I go, my students are ..!" Finally, Prof. Dr. Sanjay Pagare said, 'Sense of Fulfilment is very important..!' The program was chaired by Principal Dr. Leena Pandhre. 

He was born on 14 April 1891 in Mhow, a military camp in Madhya Pradesh. He was the fourteenth child of Subhedar Ramji Sakpal and Bhimabai Murbadkar. Babasaheb, who had been interested in education since childhood, had to endure the rigors of the strict rules of the society while studying, so he struggled all his life for the equal rights of the untouchable poor-Dalit exploited. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar is an all-round personality. He made his mark in various fields with his knowledge and deeds. The name engraved in gold letters in the history of India is Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar completed the Indian Constitution with 2 years 11 months and 18 days of hard work to enable India to stand as an independent country. Was the first law minister of independent India. He has been fighting for equal rights for women in the country. Babasaheb conveyed the message of wisdom in the dark lives of all the working farmers, hard working women. He explained the work of Babasaheb in his introduction in such a way that he made all these people aware of their rights.

After this, Prof. Bhaskar Narwate, while expressing his thoughts, explained the importance of Babasaheb's thought education. Babasaheb emphasized on eradicating illiteracy in the society through education. For this, he gave the message to all, 'Learn, unite, fight'. Babasaheb was a champion of peasant workers. Babasaheb raised his voice in Parliament for the benefit of all. He was not leading a community, he was working for all. Similarly, Babasaheb made necessary contributions for setting up river connection projects, Reserve Bank
