ACCESS Impact: Middle school students at ECISD will be enabled and skilled with "Access Essential Skills" that incudes (a) Hands-on-Learning (b) Communication (c) Collaboration (d) Soft Skills (e) Critical Thinking and (f) Collaboration skills.

Agenda: Quick Review of ACCESS Applications: Includes four cutting edge applications:

- AVATAR ICE (Intrinsic Career Engagement): Provides real-world career experience students.
- AVATAR COLLABORATION: Provides Communication, Relationship and Collaboration Skills for students.
- AVATAR GATEWAY: Provides a 21st Century, digital gateway for the Middle Schools
- AVATAR HEALTH: Provides a digital platform for student and family health information management.

ACCESS Project Implementation - How and What

Stage 1: Access Career Engagement of Students:

1. Campus Champions identify career interest of the students and inform Access IT team.

- 2. Access IT team will setup the careers on our online "Avatar Career" application.
- 3. Hospital-Champions will identify professionals at Hospital to sign-up as Career-Champions:
 - a. Career-Champions sign-up on the Avatar Career application.
 - b. Share their career experience via video or text format.
 - c. Respond to questions from students posted.
- 4. Starts in August 2018.

Stage 2: Access Career Engagement Talks:

- 1. Campus Champions identify slots available for professionals to talk with students at their respective campuses. Topics can be decided on availability speakers.
- 2. Access IT team will provide the schedule on "Avatar Collaboration" application.
- 3. ORMC-Champions will identify professionals available at the Hospital to and confirm on the Avatar Collaboration site.
- 4. Starts in September 2018.
- 5. Frequency: To be decided between the Campus and Hospital Champions.

Stage 3: Access Health Engagement:

- 1. Students are tested for fasting blood-sugar with prior approval from parents.
- 2. Access IT team will provide the online access to "Avatar Health" for students to track their health info.
- 3. Health, nutrition and fitness lectures to be scheduled as an extension of the health initiative.
- 4. Starts in November 2018.

ECISD & OC Campus-Champions:

- 1. ECISD has designated an ACCESS-Campus Champion from each one of the middle schools to coordinate that campus engagement in the ACCESS project.
- 2. Odessa College's designated coordinator for the Six Commitments program will coordinate with the six campus champions.

Hospital-Champions:

a. Designated Hospital-Champion will coordinate respective institution engagement in this project at the assigned Middle School campuses.
